Office of Emergency Management (OEM) provides planning, training, exercises, and educational outreach programs related to natural and man-made disasters to assist and prepare citizens, government agencies, and private/non-profit organizations prior to, during, and after a local emergency or disaster.

Be Ready Class — This is a 4-hour basic awareness class that briefly discusses the importance of emergency preparedness for individuals and families. Topics include planning, hazards, personal safety, hazmat/fire safety, terrorism and how you can become better educated and involved within your community. Each person completing this 4-hour class will receive a first aid kit to help them with their planning efforts.

The City of Brighton offers this **FREE** class on a quarterly basis. All classes are held at the Brighton Police Department.
